CUSTOMER ADVISORY: FUEL NEUTRALITY CHARGE

Dear Valued Customer,

The Fuel Neutrality Charge continues to be aligned with South Africa's regulated fuel pricing framework to ensure neutral cost recovery for fuel-related operational expenses at Durban Gateway Terminal (DGT) as per the letter dated 31 March 2026. The actual fuel index ([Fuel Prices \(Current & Past\) – Fuels Industry Association of South Africa](#)), is detailed below

Based on the 1 July 2026 coastal diesel price of R25.30, the applicable Fuel Neutrality Charge has been assessed in accordance with the approved tariff thresholds. This places the applicable diesel price within the R23.50 – R27 band, and therefore the **Fuel Neutrality Charge will remain at R52.00 per container handled.**

Accordingly, the Fuel Neutrality Charge of R52.00 per container will be applied to all containers handled on vessels berthing during the period: 1 September 2026 – 30 September 2026. The charges will be included on each vessel invoice.

Monthly Review

The fuel index will be reassessed on the 7th of every month and will be applied to all containers loaded or discharged on vessels berthing from 00h01 on the 1st of the following month.

Customers will be notified should any adjustment to the Fuel Neutrality Charge be required following the monthly review.
