DURBAN GATEWAY TERMINAL: RESPONSE PLAN TO POTENTIAL TRANSPORT DISRUPTIONS – 30 JUNE 2026

Dear Valued Customers and Stakeholders,

Durban Gateway Terminal (DGT) are aware of the potential risk of disruption to transport and logistics operations in KwaZulu-Natal on Tuesday, 30 June 2026. The anticipated impact may be experienced along key national routes, including the N3 and N2 corridors, as well as within the broader eThekweni metropolitan area. As a result, access to major arterial routes leading into Durban Gateway Terminal may be affected.

In preparation, DGT has proactively established a Crisis Management Committee, chaired by the Head of Security, to ensure a coordinated and effective response should any disruptions arise within the terminal precinct or surrounding landside operations. This response is being closely coordinated with the South African Police Service, the South African National Defence Force, the Transnet National Ports Authority, Durban Gateway Terminal, and the State Security Agency.

At this stage, all terminal operations are expected to continue as normal. However, management is actively monitoring the situation and remains committed to providing timely and transparent communication should any developments impact terminal or landside activities.

The safety and well-being of our employees, customers, and stakeholders remain our highest priority. While we remain optimistic that operations will proceed without incident, we are fully prepared and vigilant to respond as required.
